Guidelines for RFID Tag Placement by Item Format

For all formats - metallic print or packaging will interfere with the tag. Alternate positions will need to be considered for these items.

Books

- 1. Place the tag inside the back cover of the book, ¼ inch from the spine crease.
- 2. Alternate where you place the tag in incremental positions between the bottom, middle, and top near the spine.
- 3. Do not put tags in the crease or they will bend and not work anymore.

DVDs, Audiobooks, Playaways, Games, Blu-Rays:

- Place the tag inside the back of the paper insert/cover art, ¼ inch away from any part that bends when the case opens and closes.
- 2. Always place in the lower left of the back of the insert to prevent the metal disc from interfering with the tag being read.
- 3. Do **not** stagger the tags as you do in books.

CDs:

- 1. Remove the disc from the case.
- 2. Remove the disc bed from the case.
- 3. Place the tag on the reverse side of the insert/cover art, lower left corner near the spine.
 - a. Place the tag on the outside back cover, lower corner near the spine on the flexible CD cases or cardboard cases **that do not have inserts**.
- 4. Do **not** stagger the tags as you do in books.
- 5. Place the disc bed and disc back in the case.

Board Books:

- Place the tag on the back of the books without covering text, the ISBN, or significant artwork when possible.
- 2. Do not place the tag on the cover crease.
- 3. Place clear tape or Demco label protector over the tag to prevent loss from peeling

Magazines:

- 1. Place the tag on the inside of the back cover, not covering any significant text or photographs/artwork.
- 2. Alternate where you place the tag in incremental positions between the bottom, middle, and top near the spine.
