 - SCLS is continuing to standardize the naming convention for report files posted on the SCLS website to enable more efficient file management. The new names will include the report frequency ("daily," "weekly," "annual," etc.), the report description, and the report date formatted as 'YYYY-MM-DD' for 4-digit year (YYYY), zero-padded month number (MM), and zero-padded day number (DD – where necessary).
 - The majority of the monthly reports will be updated to the new naming convention when the reports are run for September. We will include a reminder about the new names when the regular email about the monthly reports being posted is sent.
