## Where do we go for SCLS?

- Most locations get 5 day service. Locally, the busiest locations will get twice daily service.
  - ▶ 17,000 scheduled stops per year
  - Over 250,000 containers
    - ▶ Bins, Baskets, Tubs, Totes!
    - 3750 tons moved (75 tons per week)
  - Over 10 MILLION units moved.
    - ▶ Books, CDs, DVDs: Approximate trips and sorts

**Adams County** 





- Monday Morning:
  - A patron places a hold on an available item located at Everett Roehl Public Library in Marshfield.
  - ▶ The hold joins a "pick list" at the library.
  - At some point that day, a librarian will retrieve the item, process the transfer, and place it in an outgoing red bin before the end of the day.



- Tuesday Morning:
  - SCLS Delivery arrives at the library around 11:00am and picks up that red bin and loads it on the truck for the trip back to Madison
- Tuesday afternoon:
  - ▶ SCLS staff hand sorts all of the material from the Marshfield bin into the outgoing bin for the library of the patron hold. In a best-case, the bin fills completely and it is prepared for shipment on Wednesday. If not, it will hold over one more day.







- Wednesday Morning:
  - ▶ The truck departs around 6:30am for the home library of the patron.



- Wednesday Afternoon:
  - ▶ Virtually all of the SCLS library stops have occurred and the item is in the incoming delivery. The library staff processes the materials and updates the status for the patron.
  - ▶ The item goes to a holds shelf and awaits the patron to come in and pick it up.

- ▶ This is perhaps 80% of the timing of all items.
- Holidays, weekends, and other snags do occur, but they are infrequent.
- Most often, the worst outcome extends this by just one day.



Summarizing:

► A hold placed on a Monday takes just 2 business days to get to your

home library in most cases.



## The Tools We Use:

- A dedicated Delivery Facility
  - ▶ 1650 Pankratz Street :: Down the hall from the rest of SCLS services



#### The Tools We Use:

- A fleet of 20 trucks and vans
  - ► Life expectancy of over 400,000 miles for vans
  - Auctioned at about 1/8 of their purchase as new vehicles
  - ▶ Can last over 10 years
  - ► 625,000 miles driven annually, collectively
    - ► About 40-50 years worth of a typical driver!





### The Tools We Use:

- ▶ Thousands of red bins!
  - ▶ About 1400 can move one direction or another in a single day.
- Hundreds of carts!

### What else?:

- SCLS also connects all 15 Wisconsin library systems
  - Wiscat and OCLC sharing
  - ▶ We make daily stops at 12 other systems; Contract the other 2
- SCLS connects the libraries at all University of Wisconsin campuses
- SCLS connects the libraries at most private colleges, universities, and community-based technical colleges in Wisconsin
- This broad network has been in place since the mid 1990's







#### What can I boast??

- SCLS is the most robust library delivery operation in the state of Wisconsin. Arguably in the whole Midwest.
  - ▶ Full time, benefitted staff
  - Professional, long-term employees
- Material movement statistics suggest that our volumes are similar to major metropolitan areas like King County Washington.
- We do it all by hand! With few errors and extremely rare damage
